The Manly West P&C is a vital part of the school community and has a proud history of helping make Manly West the Best.

- Enrichment programs for students and families

Our aim is to bring parents, citizens, students and teaching staff together and assist in providing and maintaining equipment, tools and resources for the school over and above departmental funding.

Over the years, through the support of the school community, the P&C has funded key resources for the school including the coloured equipment, the Kitchen Garden, the BASC amphitheatre, the oval upgrade and the COLA. The P&C has also provided classroom resources and sporting equipment. Our latest major project was the installation of the two new BASC buildings to support the needs of parents and increasing the BASC numbers.

To make all these things possible, we rely heavily on the support of our school community and volunteers.

Uniform

The Manly West Uniform Shop stocks all Manly West uniform items.

There are two options for purchasing uniform items:

- In person at the uniform shop, or
- Through the Flexischools website www.flexischools.com.au

New parents to Manly West can order uniforms via either purchase option. Uniform orders through Flexischools are processed daily and are delivered to the school office for new Kindy starters. Parents are notified by text message when their order is ready for collection. Orders for older students are delivered to their classroom.

There's also a second-hand option where uniforms can be purchased at heavily discounted prices. Please visit the Uniform Shop to pick up a bargain.

Payments at the Uniform Shop can be made via cash, EFTPOS or credit card.

Before and After School Care (BASC)

The Manly West P&C is very proud to offer high quality, not-for-profit before and after school care to the families of Manly West. We are currently licensed to offer care for 210 children each morning and afternoon. We also offer care on pupil free days.

Quality and Engaging Care

The MW BASC is highly regarded amongst the school and wider community. Children participate in a range of activities including craft, sport, cooking, drama, games and much more. The Centre also offers incursions where specialist providers provide diverse and inspiring activities in which children can participate.

Special theme days are run throughout the year including picnics, parties and appearances by special guests to celebrate various occasions. Parents are notified of these special occasions in advance.

Rates and Hours

Manly West Before and After School Care is an Approved Childcare provider. Child Care Benefit and Tax Rebates are available to eligible children.

The Manly West Before and After School Care Centre operates the following hours:

Before School Care 7:00am to 9:00am After School Care 3:20pm to 6:30pm

Before School Care \$12.90 After School Care \$20.80

Enrolments

All Manly West families are eligible to enroll at BASC.

Please be aware that there are significant waiting lists for BASC across all year groups from Kindergarten through to Year 6.

We continue to look at ways of expanding BASC numbers to meet the needs of the MW families. In 2019, we installed two new buildings and we granted permission by the Department of Education to use one of the school classrooms to increase our BASC student numbers.

Band

The multi award winning MW Band program is a big part of the MW community and is available to students from Year 3 onwards. There are four bands – the training band, intermediate band, performance band and concert band. Students in K-2 will be entertained by the bands at assemblies and special events throughout the year.

The Kitchen Garden

The Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden program was implemented in 2012.

The program supports a range of curriculum areas across a number of key learning areas, and it is often referred to as our 'outdoor classroom'. All students from Kindergarten to Year 6 will have an opportunity to use this outdoor classroom throughout the year.

The Kitchen Garden program provides an opportunity for students to plant, harvest, prepare and share food grown.

Parents and community members are invited to assist with the maintenance of our garden and to support students with cooking and art projects when required.

The Kitchen Garden program is a place where our garden grows and so do our students!

The P&C Sub-Committees

Events and Fundraising committee host a range of social events and fundraising programs each year to help build the sense of school community and to raise much needed funds for the school. To ensure we cater for all tastes the P&C hosts at least one event and one fundraising program each term. The first event on the school calendar is the exclusive Kindy Parents Cocktail social event. See section below.

Enrichment committee runs programs for students and at times families as well. These are usually held on a weekend of an evening at the MW school campus.

Environmental and Sustainability committee researches and investigates ways the school can reduce waste and be more energy efficient.

The **Sun Safety** committee supports the Sun Smart program and ensures the students become sun smart aware.

Traffic committee engages in traffic awareness and safety programs, particularly parking areas and the two kiss and drop zones.

P&C Contributions

The P&C Contribution are voluntary payments that help provide amazing resources to all Manly West students.

The amount appears on your child's semester account and the recommended amount payable is \$75 per student or \$150 per family.

Each year the payment alternates between the Library Fund and the Building Fund.

The funds raised through the contributions benefit all students in the school and allows the school to provide quality resources and facilities for our students over and above department funding.

The best thing . . . Your P&C Contribution is fully tax deductible.

Class Parents

Class Parents act as the vital liaison between the classroom teacher and the parents and carers of students.

Class parents also pass on important information to the class from the P&C.
